OPEN, NOVICE, INCENTIVES CAMPDRAFT & CHALLENGE TERMS

- Horses and owners will only be eligible for prize money if ALL of the following conditions are complied with: Campdraft Prize Money paid in accordance with ACA Rules R.8 & R.9.
- ALL competitors will need to be current financial members of the Australian Stock Horse Society, in order to compete in these events. Membership options available are Full membership, Participant membership or Temporary membership for those who have not been an ASHS member in the last five years. Please contact ASHS 02 6545 2165 for info.
- Darling Downs Member prizes for active working committee members.
- Campdrafts run under NCCA Competition rules and guidelines.
- ALL horses must be registered with the Australian Stockhorse Society and be competition eligible.
- Horses full registered ASHS name & registration number MUST BE used when nominating.
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Prize money will be paid to the person nominated in Campdraft Central (please check account details).
- The status of horse will change according to the highest status horse in the event.
- A 'passed in' horse is eligible if it is purchased and lodged with the agent within 48 hours of the completion of the sale.
- Scratchings 100% refund prior to 8am 19th November 2023 after this date will forfeit the entire nomination fee.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint in relation to an Event, must lodge the complaint in writing to the Secretary of the DDASHS Branch within one hour of the incident taking place. Refer Section 24 of the ASHS handbook. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the DDASHS Branch, the \$50 fee is forfeited.
- All competitors under 18 years must wear a helmet at all times when mounted on grounds.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or any terms and conditions
- In the event that your power arrangement causes fault to the electrical supply and requires an electrician to visit the grounds the person responsible for the fault may be responsible for paying the electrician should it be deemed that your power arrangements were negligent.
- Full payment to be received by 20th November 2023
- All competitors will need to present to the secretary's office to receive a competitors wristband. This will be provided upon confirmation of all paperwork including payment of nominations, current membership, horse health declarations. A competitor will not be able to enter the camp or challenge arena without this wristband.
- All competitors must adhere to COVID-19 Regulations in place.

EVENT & NOMINATION TERMS

GELDING, AGED CHAMPIONS

- Horses that meet the conditions can compete in both the Aged Champions & the Donrica Gelding Incentive Campdrafts.
- Horses can only compete if purchased from 2010 onwards.
- · Horses can only compete twice under the same ownership.
- · Incentive drafts consist of One First round and Final. Places are paid on aggregate scores.
- Purchased horses must be transferred into the purchaser's name and remain in the purchasers name to be eligible.
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be supplied if requested.

 A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Any horse that has won an Incentive Draft is not eligible to return under the same ownership.
- Horses that compete in the Gelding Incentive must be ridden by the owner or immediate family (Example: Husband, Wife, Son, Daughter).
- ALL competitors will need to be current financial members of the Australian Stock Horse Society, in order to compete in these events. Membership options available are Full membership, Participant membership or Temporary membership for those who have not been an ASHS member in the last five years. - Horses will still be eligible even if horse has changed ownership since the original purchase (please provide info to the secretary).
- One Round and Final.



1	At A acknowledge the judges and at a working trot, trot to X and Stop.
2	2 spins left.
3	2 spins right.
4	Canter a small slow circle left. Canter a large fast circle left. At X flying change
5	Canter a large fast circle right. Canter a small slow circle right. At X flying change.
6	Canter large fast to the left, do not close. Run down to A. At A stop and without hesitation do a right rollback.
7	Run down to C and stop without hesitation do a left roll back
8	Run past B and stop and settle horse back up at least 5 paces.
9	Acknowledge Judge, walk out of arena on loose rein cracking whip.
10	Overall Presentation & Conformation.
